- Optionally, if you also plan to certify - Execute Certification Agreement & Return to Corticon

TRAINING COURSE LOGISTICS

We recommend you rent a car - neither the training facility, nor hotels and restaurants are within walking distance.

Other logistical information:

- Training will be done on attendee's laptops. Please note the following laptop requirements:

- Coffee & Danish or Bagels and Lunch will be provided on all three days. If your attendee(s) have any dietary requirements (vegan, vegetarian, kosher, etc), please make sure to note it in the comments section on the registration form.

AIRPORTS AND DIRECTIONS

The training facility is located close to several airports in the San Francisco Bay Area. Distance and approximate times to the training facility from airports and downtown San Francisco:

- 11 miles or approximately 15 minutes from San Francisco Airport (SFO)
- 25 miles or approximately 30 minutes from the San Jose International Airport (SJC)
- 28 miles or approximately 35 minutes from the Oakland International Airport (OAK)
- 25 miles or approximately 35-40 minutes freeway time from downtown San Francisco



Please note, the times are approximate and will deviate from estimates based on time of travel (peak commute time vs. lunch time).

Directions to the Training Facility

From San Francisco (& SFO Airport):

1. Take Highway 101 south, towards San Jose.
2. Take the RALSTON AVE exit- EXIT 412- toward BELMONT.
3. Turn left onto RALSTON AVE.
4. RALSTON AVE becomes MARINE PKWY / MARINE WORLD PKWY.
5. Turn LEFT onto ISLAND DR.

From San Jose (& SJC Airport) :

1. Start out going NORTHEAST on AIRPORT PKWY toward TECHNOLOGY DR.
2. Turn RIGHT onto OLD BAYSHORE HWY.
3. Turn SHARP LEFT onto N 1ST ST.
4. Merge onto US-101 N toward SAN FRANCISCO.
5. Take the RALSTON AVENUE / MARINE PARKWAY exit- EXIT 412- toward BELMONT.
6. Turn RIGHT onto RALSTON AVE.
7. RALSTON AVE becomes MARINE PKWY / MARINE WORLD PKWY.
8. Turn LEFT onto ISLAND DR.

From Oakland Airport:

1. Start out going SOUTHWEST on AIRPORT DR toward ALAN SHEPARD WAY.
2. Turn RIGHT onto ALAN SHEPARD WAY.
3. Turn RIGHT onto JOHN GLENN DR.
4. Turn LEFT onto AIRPORT DR.
5. Turn RIGHT onto DOOLITTLE DR / CA-61
6. Turn LEFT onto DAVIS ST / CA-112 / CA-61.
7. Merge onto I-880 S toward SAN JOSE.
8. Merge onto CA-92 W toward SAN MATEO BR (Portions toll).
9. Merge onto US-101 S toward SAN JOSE.
10. Take the RALSTON AVE exit- EXIT 412- toward BELMONT.
11. Turn LEFT onto RALSTON AVE.
12. RALSTON AVE becomes MARINE PKWY / MARINE WORLD PKWY.
13. Turn LEFT onto ISLAND DR.

From Downtown San Francisco:

1. Merge onto US-101 S via the ramp on the LEFT toward SAN JOSE.
2. Take the RALSTON AVE exit- EXIT 412- toward BELMONT.
3. Turn LEFT onto RALSTON AVE.
4. RALSTON AVE becomes MARINE PKWY / MARINE WORLD PKWY
5. Turn LEFT onto ISLAND DR.
6. End at 1300 Island Dr

OTHER INFORMATION

Weather

The climate in Redwood City, CA is generally mild--a true composite of the weather experienced by those residing in San Jose and San Francisco. The proximity to San Francisco Bay keeps the climate moderate and comfortable year 'round. Redwood City has an average high temperature of 77° from April through September, and 63° from October through March, with over 160 sunny days per year. Even with the best weather in the bay area, travelers are wise to pack for a variety of weather conditions. Layers are best; so you can put on/take off clothing based on the weather conditions. Traffic
